**What is a Telecourse?**

**How does the course work?**

- View 30 minute program segment once a week on Alabama Public Television, starting **October 24-December 12, 2015** from 7:00 – 7:30am Central time
- Follow directions and complete questions received at orientation
- Receive contact from CCRC following each program
