The Whole Child is a 13-program series delivered as a series of 30-minute programs for Broadcast Distance Learning. It provides essential information about children’s physical, emotional, and cognitive development. It also offers techniques to use in difficult situations and shows how to help children develop to their fullest potential. It also shows techniques used to help both caregiver and child get the most out of time spent together.

What is a Telecourse?

A combination of a televised program and independent study with written exercises

How does the course work?

- Register using this form
- Attend orientation class on January 4, from 6:00 – 7:00pm
- Read program overview prior to viewing the weekly segment
- View 30-minute program segment once a week on Alabama Public Television, starting January 6, from 7:00 – 7:30am
- Follow directions and complete questions received at orientation
- You MUST have access to a television that receives APTV in order to participate

When is the course held?

- Orientation is Thursday, January 4, 6:00pm – 7:00pm CST at CCRC
- The mid-session is February 20, from 6:00 – 7:00pm.
- The remaining sessions are to be completed independently each Saturday from January 6 to March 31, 7:00 – 7:30am
- The final turn-in session will be held Thursday, April 5, 2017 6:00 – 7:00pm

Enrollment is on a first come first serve basis. There is a course maximum of 40 participants.

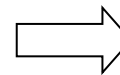
